
"The Spice of Life" variety extravaganza on Saturday 15th March 2014,

- 2) Donation to the Gandhi Centre in Sri Lanka for setting up of more "Sustainable Agricultural Resource Centres" ("SARC") in the Northern parts of Sri Lanka, where mostly Ex LTTE cadres are actively involved as a major part of their rehabilitation process.
- 3) Donation towards housing for the homeless in Kilinochchi.
- 4) Donation to a Tailoring teaching project for women (mostly single) in Batticaloa, under the auspices of the Swami Vivekananda Institute.
- 5) Donation to The Australian Tamil Management Service for their 'grass roots' self help programmes in Jaffna.

We have selected these particular needs as our beneficiaries in the spirit of healing, brotherhood and compassionate love that we seek to bring to life.
